

## Western Kern County ARES® Membership Requirements



- 1. Valid Technician or higher Amateur Radio License
- 2. Complete and return ARRL FSD 98
- 3. For an ID Card to be issued or renewed, or to purchase ARES<sup>®</sup> apparel, you must complete and pass the ARRL Emergency Communications course either by self study or at a training session.
- 4. Maintain current contact information on file with the Administrative Officer.
  - a. Telephone number(s)
  - b. Street Address / Mailing Address
  - c. Email address
- Continuing Education is highly encouraged for all members and required for Command Staff participation.
  - a. Routinely participate in the weekly ARES® 2 meter net.
  - Attend at least one training session or participate in at least one field exercise annually.
- 6. These FEMA courses are recommended:
  - a. IS 100
  - b. IS 200
  - c. IS 700
  - d. IS 800
- The Command Staff may waive or alter any of the above requirements in extenuating circumstances by majority vote.
